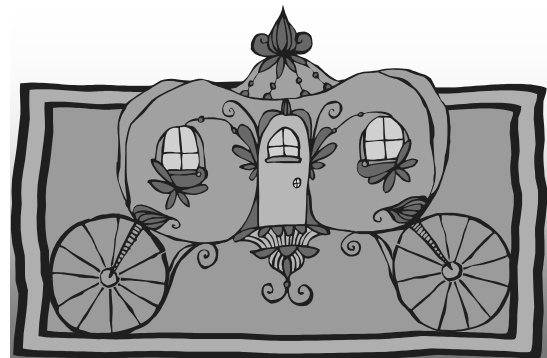

Q: Will I be reimbursed for the prescription medications I paid for that were prescribed for my injury?

A: Yes, You are entitled to reimbursement for the amount you paid for prescription medications, as long as they were prescribed by your doctor as a result of the injuries you suffered in the accident.



The amount you paid will be included in the total settlement you receive. It is important that you keep receipts for all of

your out of pocket expenses and give them to your attorney so that he/she may include this amount when negotiating your settlement.

Cases In the News:

Chinese Man's Last Meal was a Rare One

A Chinese man received 12 years in prison after killing and eating a rare tiger in China. He claimed that he killed the tiger in self-defense while he was gathering clams. The court felt that it was unnecessary for him to be carrying a gun with him at the time. As a result, he was



sentenced to 2 years imprisonment for illegal possession of firearms and 10 years for killing an endangered animal.

Officer Fails to Aid Strangled Girl

The family of an 11-year old girl received \$2.2 million due to inju-

ries that could have been avoided. Police officer Kendrick Wong reportedly discovered the girl, unconscious with her neck caught in a rope loop attached to a zip line on the playground. Wong believed her to be dead so he began to take pictures of her instead of calling for medical assistance.

By the time paramedics came, she had suffered irreversible brain damage. As a result, the girl's parents sued the city police department for negligence.
